More than one parent evening a year

We have a statutory duty to report to parents about their child's progress three times a year. We do this through two face to face consultation evenings (with a report) and a longer, more detailed report at the end of the year. If a teacher has a concern about the progress of a child, they will arrange to meet with a parent and share information.

School apps

We use Class Dojo, ParentMail, and in EYFS Tapestry. The apps have different purposes, and as such as are all essential. ParentMail is used for official letters, newsletters and first aid notifications. Class Dojo is used for class and whole school updates, as well as giving you the opportunity to privately message staff. Tapestry is only used in EYFS, which shares learning between school and home.
