



12 CIT school buildings fitted with solar panels

CIT currently employs over 750 staff and caters for over 2,500 pupils across the East Midlands.

We are holding our first ever annual conference - The CIT Inclusion Fiesta - with 850 delegates attending the event this September.

As part of the Trust's continuing commitment to reducing environmental impact, we are proud to report that solar panels have been installed on the roofs of twelve CIT school builds providing us with sustainable, noise free, pollution free energy.

We are estimating a reduction in our carbon footprint annually by 45.34 tonnes - that is the equivalent of saving over 2,000 trees (6 acres of Forest) each year!
