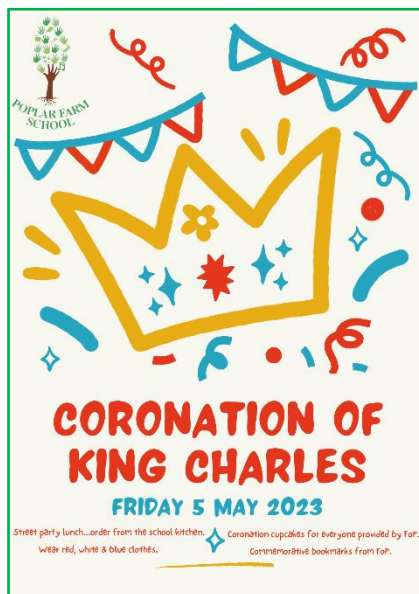
Coronation Events
