


CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

HOMEWORK AND READING RECORDS

Homework will be set every Friday and will be due in the following Thursday. It is your child's responsibility to complete and hand in their homework independently. As the year progresses, the children will be given additional tasks to complete in order to prepare them for secondary school e.g. research for upcoming topics.

Reading records need to be in school everyday and signed by an adult weekly to show reading is monitored at home. They will be collected in and checked every Monday by the class teacher. Children will read with an adult in school weekly.

If children read 4 times at home, then they will receive a raffle ticket, this gives them the opportunity to win a ticket for the vending machine, half termly.




PE DAYS - AUTUMN TERM

Please ensure your child has a white t-shirt, trainers and long jogging bottoms or black shorts as their PE kit.




SATS
