Unauthorised absences

As you are aware we monitor attendance daily and currently inform you at the end of a term if attendance has fallen below 90% (the equivalent of 1 day a fortnight off school), as this is classed as persistence absence.

In line with current <u>guidance</u> we now issue Fixed Penalty Notice warning letters for unauthorised holidays. From September 2024, <u>new guidance</u> will be in place with increased fines and a higher chance of prosecution. Paragraph 38 of the new guidance states that a holiday is not an exceptional circumstance and paragraph 180 gives information about the penalties.

The DfE recognises the importance of high attendance at school for pupil well being and education, and we hope you consider the new attendance statutory guidance before booking a holiday during term time.
