Dear Parents / Carers,

Firstly, thank you for your support during this academic year. In a year where everyone has faced challenges with the cost-of-living crisis, your financial support for enrichment activities to continue for the children has been gratefully received.

As mentioned in the newsletter earlier this week, following the recent proposals, the beginning / end of day arrangements will be as follows:

- Gates open at 8.40am, for registration at 8.45am.
- An additional gate will be open in the morning, which means 4 gates for the children to use. The gates are situated:
 - Near FYFS area
 - o KS2 playground
 - o 2 gates along the footpath at the back of the school.
- The school day will end at 3.15pm for children in EYFS, Y1 and Y2. The children can be collected from their classroom doors.
- The school day will end at 3.25pm for children in KS2. Y3 and Y4 children can be collected from the KS1 playground, and Y5 and Y6 children can be collected from the KS2 playground.

The changes to the end of the day means that our Celebration Assemblies will now take place at 9am every Friday, rather than at the end of the day.

The children still have many activities to enjoy during the rest of this term, including a visit from an Ice-Cream Van on Friday afternoon, when FoP will buy an ice-cream for every child in school. Thank you FoP!
