

This term we will be exploring significant figures, both historic and modern day. We will learn what makes someone significant and compare the achievements of a range of explorers. This term we also get to celebrate our two-day festival - PopFest! Children will participate in a range of enrichment activities. Our PE days remain the same, Monday and Friday.

Maths

To compare and sequence intervals of time.

To tell and write the time to five minutes, including quarter past/to the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

To know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day.

To order and arrange combinations of mathematical objects in patterns and sequences.

To use mathematical vocabulary to describe position, direction and movement, including movement in a straight line and distinguishing between rotation as a turn and in terms of right angles for quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anticlockwise).

We will explore the narrative 'George and the Dragon' and make links to the film 'How to Change your Dragon'. We will learn about subordinating conjunctions, similes, and applying thoughts and feelings to a narrative.

We will learn about the features of a biography and create a factual biography about a significant historic figure.

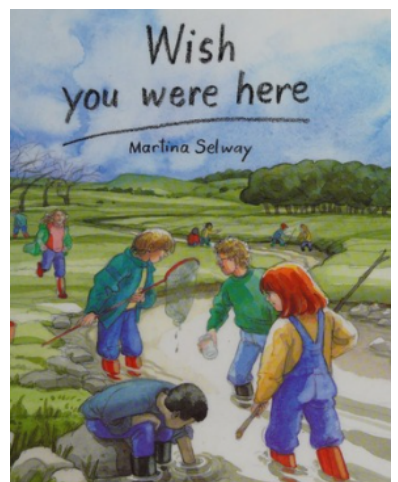
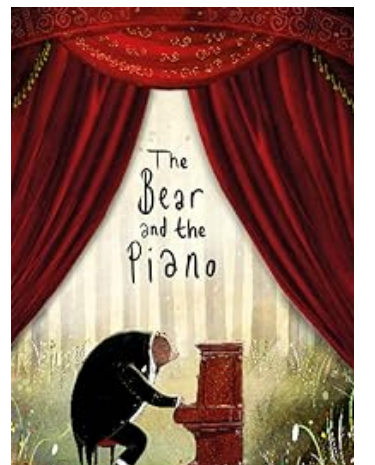
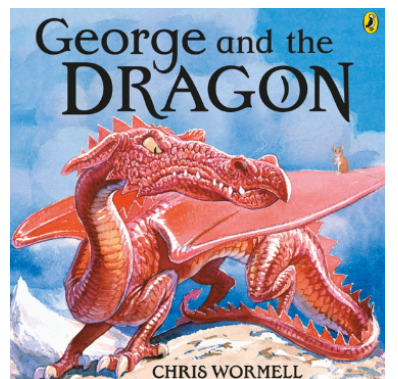
To understand pushing and pulling can move things faster or slower, move and stop.
