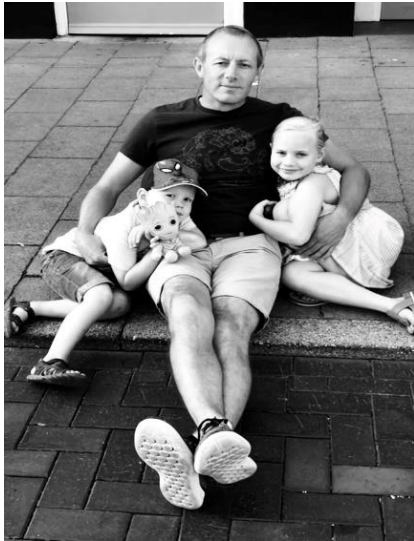




Transition for September 2024 - Meet the teachers!
